Re: Inlet Management (SB 1672)

Senator Jones,

The Florida Coastal and Ocean Coalition would like to commend you for sponsoring Senate Bill 1672, Inlet Management legislation, to help restore the natural flow of sand along Florida's coasts. As water flow is the cornerstone of Everglades restoration, so is the return of natural sand flow to our beaches; your bill is landmark legislation for the preservation of our shores.

Almost half of Florida's sandy shoreline is designated "critically" eroded and the Department of Environmental Protection has identified navigational inlets as a leading contributor of coastal erosion. It is clearly in the long term interest of Florida and its beach management program to place a high priority on efficient inlet sand by-pass. We are pleased to see this sustainable policy being proposed for the future of Florida's coasts.

Florida depends heavily upon a healthy coastal ecosystem. It is home to many of Florida's signature wildlife, the backbone of our tourist based economy and our primary defense from storms and sea-level rise. Parks along our shores are the most visited and popular in the State park system; many contend that Florida's beach and dune system is one of the state's most valuable natural resources.

Your legislation will greatly assist in the "natural re-nourishment" of the beaches that Floridians cherish. Thank you for your continuing leadership on beach protection legislation.
